**Access Notice**  
The only authorized access onto Fort Huachuca is through Main, East, or West Gates. Any other entry is illegal, and anyone caught coming through a remote gate (or over the fence) could be apprehended and cited for trespassing.

**CAUTION**  
HUNTING AND ILLEGAL TRAPPING MAY BE ENCOURAGED IN THIS AREA

Multi-use trails are multi-use. Bicycles are not allowed on trails in Wilderness Area. Maximum 20' trailer length on Carr Canyon Road.

Rock Service trails are foot-use only; no bicycles, except horses are allowed on trail, starting from Montezuma Pass. Pets may be leashed. Maximum 24' vehicle length on Montezuma Canyon Road.

Fort Huachuca requires a Driver's License, registration and proof of insurance.
